China – Revision of Terminal Handling Charges

Dear Customer,

We wish to inform you that the Terminal Handling Charges (THC) for all Mainland China ports will change. Effective as of **April 1, 2019** and valid until further notice the THC for all Mainland China ports will be adjusted by the following quantum:

Trade (to / from China)	Effective Date	
All Trades	April 1, 2019 until further notice	

Adjustment of THC Quantum	All 20' Container Types	All 40' Container Types
All Mainland China Port Locations	Less CNY 9	Less CNY 18

The THC will apply for all trades, including trades to and from Europe. The Ocean Tariff rates as well as Bunker-related surcharges, Security-related surcharges, Peak Season surcharges (if applicable) and other THCs remain unchanged respectively as announced and can be found [here](#).

Other local charges and contingency surcharges may apply in addition.
